Why Large caps?

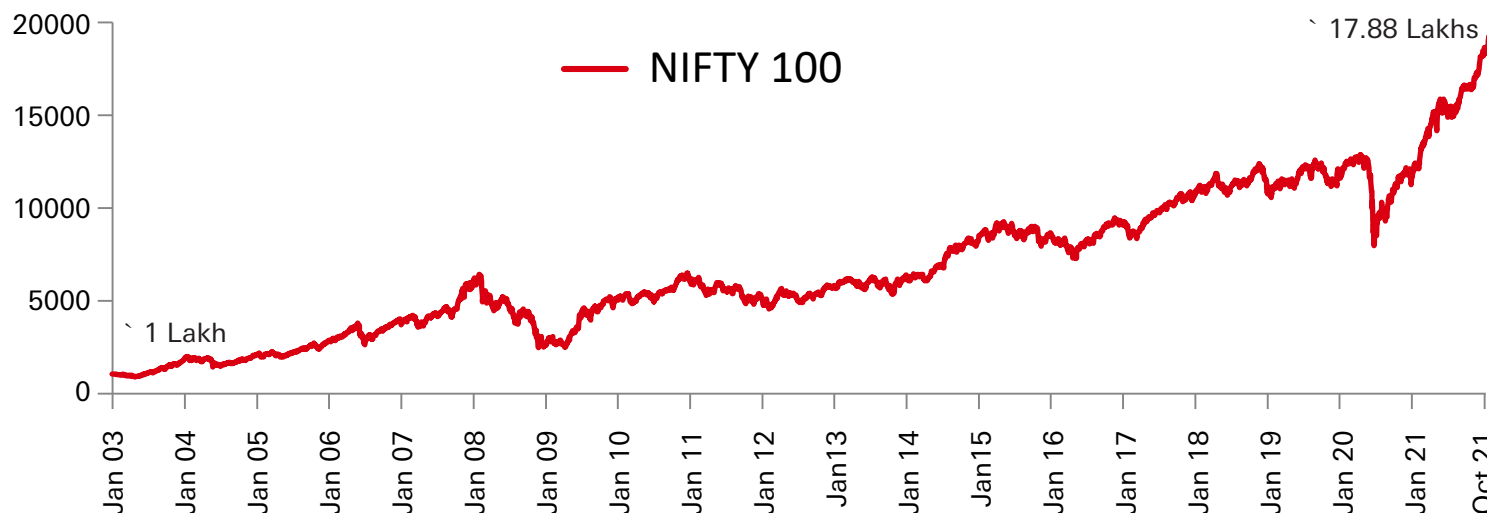
- Opportunity to invest in top 100 companies (by market capitalisation)

Wealth creation potential of Large Caps



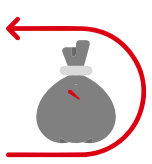
