About L&T Nifty 50 Index Fund

This Fund would track the Nifty 50 which is the index on the National Stock Exchange of India Ltd. (NSE). The index tracks the behavior of a portfolio of blue chip companies, the largest and most liquid Indian securities. It includes 50 of the approximately 1,600 companies traded and captures approximately 65% of its float-adjusted market capitalization and is considered a good reflection of the Indian stock market.

The Nifty 50 covers major sectors of the Indian economy and offers investment managers exposure to the Indian market in one efficient portfolio. Index funds are majorly subject to tracking error.


