Investment Objective

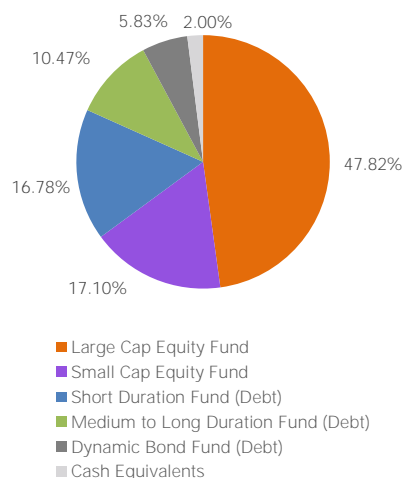
