NOTICE-CUM-ADDENDUM

Potential Risk Class Matrix for debt schemes based on Interest Rate Risk and Credit Risk

NOTICE is hereby given that in order to help investors take more informed decisions, SEBI vide its circular no. SEBI/HO/IMD/IMD-II DOF3/P/CIR/2021/573 dated June 07, 2021, has mandated for debt schemes to also display (in addition to the risk-o-meter) the Potential Risk Class ('PRC') matrix i.e. the maximum interest rate risk (measured by Macaulay Duration of the scheme) and maximum credit risk (measured by Credit Risk Value of the scheme) the fund manager can take in the scheme.

Accordingly, in accordance with the provisions of aforesaid SEBI circular, following PRC matrix (calculated in accordance with the methodology prescribed in the said SEBI circular) stands inserted in the Scheme Information Document (SID) and Key Information Document (KIM) of following debt schemes of HSBC Mutual Fund ('the Fund') along with the description of the PRC matrix which shall be integral part of the existing description of 'type of the scheme', with effect from December 01, 2021:
