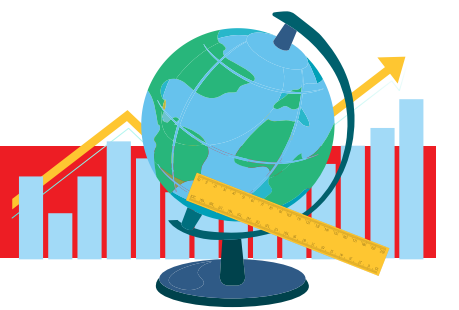


Investments are the best teachers.
